Denmark	<p>Copenhagen Business School (CBS LAW) can provide offices for up to two PhD students or professors from Ukraine. This includes access to CBS' library, various databases etc. Unfortunately, they cannot pay any salary or provide accommodation.</p> <p>Even though CBS as an institution currently cannot provide accommodation and financial support, the employees of CBS' Tax Law Group would be happy to try personally assisting Ukrainian scholars in applying for (free/cheap) accommodation in Denmark and financial support from other sources to the extent possible.</p> <p>Copenhagen Business School is in the process of setting up a procedure for helping Ukrainians with accommodation and financial support.
